RACE DESCRIPTION:

The race will be held at Homestake Lodge, a cross country ski area at the top of Homestake pass on I-90, just east of Butte, and on Forest Service land backing the XC ski area. The course is a 6-7-mile loop comprised of double-track and single track. The course will be fast, rolling terrain that will suit all around riders. Registration is from 9:30 AM – 10:30 A.M; the race will begin at 11:00 A.M. following a short kids race (kids race first to allow parents to run beside their kids if needed).

To get to Homestake Lodge, take the Homestake exit from I-90 at the top of Homestake pass. On the south side of the interstate, turn onto FS 240 road for 3 miles, paralleling I-90 eastward. The road is manageable for most vehicles. Post race awards will be done at the lodge.

All Expert category racers must have an annual license.

There are showers available and an area to wash your bikes after the race. This race will be spectator friendly, family friendly and will have a short course kids race.
