

# Montana State Time Trial Championship

**Saturday August 1, 2009**

**Course:** a 40-km out-and-back along the Warm Springs Frontage road. The course is nearly flat, with one overpass near the turnaround point. Course will be open to traffic. Registration and the Start/Finish will be on the frontage road near the town of Opportunity (see "Directions," below).

**Registration:** opens at 9:00 a.m. and closes at 10:30 a.m. On-site, day-of-race registration only. Entry fee includes USA Cycling insurance/MBRA surcharges. First rider starts at 11:00 a.m.

**Rules:** All USA Cycling rules apply. Racers must wear helmets while racing and warming up/down. Race course will be open to motor vehicles, and the centerline and no-drafting rules will be strictly enforced. USA Cycling annual or one-day licenses are required and may be purchased on-site (remember that **one-day license holders** may only race as Cat. 5 or Masters men, or Cat. 4 women, and they **are not eligible for state championship medals**.) Place numbers on right side of jersey. This event is part of the Hammer Nutrition/Le Petit Outré/Big Sky Brewing 2009 Road Race Series, and you will earn double-points for your efforts.

**Prizes:** Cash and/or merchandise (total to be determined by turnout, not to exceed \$499). State Championship medals will be awarded to Montana residents with annual licenses. Award ceremony will follow the completion of the event, and will be held on site.

**Directions:** Traveling west or east on I-90, take Hwy. 1 (Exit 208) toward Anaconda. Head west on MT-1 for 2.7 miles. Turn right at Stewart Street and proceed 2.3 miles to where it intersects with the frontage road. Registration and parking will be to the south of Stewart Street; the start/finish will be to the north.
