FORMAT: The Little Rockies Classic is a point-to-point stage race involving 3 stages in 2 days. We will be using the time format. Saturday the 1st has two stages; a prologue and a road race. Sunday has a road race that starts in Zortman **not Malta**. We will provide luggage transportation for all racers throughout the race. There will be no shuttles from Malta to Zortman on Saturday. Anything you want needs to be put in the luggage vehicle before the start of stage 2. Personal luggage vehicles can follow the race and meet the group in Zortman.

<u>TERRAIN:</u> See the race website for course maps and elevation profiles, http://americanprairieclassic.blogspot.com/. Stage 1 is an uphill 3.4 mile prologue. Stage 2 is 49 miles of rolling terrain with an uphill finish. Stage 3 is 70 miles. It starts out rolly and turns into a flat run into the finish.

REGISTRATION: The stage race costs \$50 Online and \$60 day of. Single event registration is available; \$10 Stage 1, \$25 Stage 2, \$25 Stage 3. Race Headquarters is located at Malta High School (1 High School Lane S. 9th St. W.)

<u>DIRECTIONS</u>: Malta, MT is 80 miles east of Havre on hwy 2. It's a 4 hour drive from Billings, 5 hour drive from Bozeman, 4 hour drive from Great Falls, and a 7 hour drive from Missoula.
