The Courses:

The TT course (11 miles) will be flat & fast, same course as last year without the short climb. Start will be from the staging area, make a U turn, then head out of town to turn around. Finish will be at staging area after a slight rise. Riders will go off in reverse order of registration, last to register first to ride.

The RR course is one of CMJC's regular training courses. The route follows a smooth, scenic, lightly traveled road in the Highwood area. Cat 1/2/3 racer will ride to the turnaround at the outside of Fort Benton (20 Miles) all other groups will turn around at a mid point turnaround (9 Miles) all riders will continue past the finish line to a second turnaround at McKinnor Rd (14 miles past start line). All groups will finish at the same finish line. Race course has a mixture of hills, as well as scenic views. Pavement is in great shape throughout the course with the exception of a short gravel section that will be traversed twice. The course will be open to vehicular traffic and the centerline rule will be enforced at all times, this includes the finish.

Racers will complete a total distance of 47 to 65 miles. Racers who are in the main groups may ride more than two abreast, but will remain to the right of the centerline at all times. Racers who are not in the main groups or otherwise out-of-contention will ride as far to the right hand side of the road as possible.

Race Schedule:*

Registration: 8:00 to 9:30am
Pre-race meeting: 9:45am

TT Start – 1st rider will go @ 10am, 30 second intervals

RR Start

Group 1 Men Category 1/2/3 2:00 pm start, 65 Miles

Group 2 Men Category 4/5, Masters A, Women 2/3 2:05 pm start, 47 Miles

Group 3 Women 4, Masters B, Jr A (25 miles) 2:10 pm start, 47 Miles

Juniors B will immediately follow Group 3 and race 22 miles (2 laps on TT course).

** Promoter reserves the right to combine or expand race groupings as conditions, attendance and volunteer support warrant.*

**All USCF rules apply. Racers must wear helmets while racing or warming up/down.*

**Junior gear restrictions will be enforced.*

Prizes:

Cash (total to be determined by turnout) will not exceed \$499. Awards will follow the completion of all the races and will be held at the registration area. Medals for all Junior Events.

Fees:

\$25 race entry fee. USCF annual or one-day licenses required and are available for purchase on-site; MBRA permanent race numbers also available at race. All juniors will race for free in Jr A/B race.

Participants are encouraged to obtain licenses and memberships in advance of race day registration.

Directions:

From Great Falls, go east on Hwy 200, turn left on Hwy 228. Proceed 13 miles to Hwy 331, turn left to Highwood School (11 Miles). The School (registration / start line) will be on the right hand side (South) of the road.

From East & South, turn north at Armington Junction, (Armington Road), turn right on Hwy 331, follow road to Highwood School (20 Miles). The School (registration / start line) will be on the right hand side (South) of the road.
