**The Course:** Located on the backroads between Drummond, Helmville, and the scenic Bearmouth area, this classic out-and-back course features numerous short hills, a big, twisty climb/descent, and lots of rolling terrain. It's a course where tactics and strategy could prove decisive. The road surface ranges from smooth asphalt to rough chip-seal; this year, expect numerous potholes. Sturdy wheels and stout tires are highly recommended.

**Rules:** All USA Cycling rules apply. Participants must wear helmets while racing and warming up and down. Race course will be open to motor vehicles, and the centerline rule will be strictly enforced. USA Cycling annual or one-day licenses are required and may be purchased on-site (remember that **one-day license holders may only race as Cat. 5 or Masters B men, or Cat. 4 women**). Follow vehicles will accompany each field: wheels in/wheels out. Race will be neutral while passing through the town of Drummond, except at the finish.

**Prizes:** Cash & merchandise (total to be determined by turnout), not to exceed \$499. An award ceremony will follow the completion of all the races and will be held in Drummond, location TBA.

**Registration:** \$25 entry fee for pre-registrants; \$30 on day of race. No charge for racers in the "Junior" division. Sign up via [USA Cycling's on-line service](#). Pre-registration deadline: 10:00 p.m. MDT, Friday, April 29. Sorry, no mail-in registration. Entry fees include USA Cycling insurance and MBRA surcharges.

**Directions:** From the west, take I-90 to Exit 153; from the east, take I-90 to Exit 154. Follow the signs to downtown Drummond, head south on Main Street for approximately ½ mile to the city park and campground. Check-in/registration, staging, parking, water, toilets, etc. will be located here.
