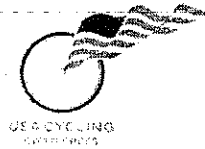

**Race Description:** South hills cross-country course; spectator-friendly. Combination of dirt roads, jeep trails, and single-track.

**Directions:** Mid-way between downtown Helena and the Capital Complex, find the intersection of Broadway and Davis. Drive south on Davis approx. 2 miles. Davis will turn to dirt and get narrow. Proceed past Archery Range on your left to Davis Gulch Trailhead (Old Shooting Range). Same day-same venue as the WERKS MTB race. \*
