### Butte CX Weekend

The Butte CX weekend will award overall prizes for the top finishers in each category based on an Omni scoring system with the Saturday Psyco-cross race as the queen event.

### September 29 – Psyco-Cross

**Race Description:** Homestake Lodge XC area lighted ski course! The 1.5 mile lighted course is 15+ feet wide and a mix of undulating terrain with one long run up, one dismount area, and several course obstacles to test your handling skills. The course is lit well, but you are allowed to use headlamps at your discretion.

**Registration:** \$25 pre-registration will be available via USA Cycling. Juniors Free if pre-registered. \$50 race-day registration is available from 5:30 to 7:15 p.m. (juniors not pre-registered \$25). No refunds. First race begins at 7:45 pm

#### All USAC Rules apply

- USAC license required. Racers without a 2012 annual license must purchase a one-day license for \$10.
- Juniors racing their categories will not be eligible for cash prizes.
- Promoters reserve the right to combine classes.
