

Pedal the Pintlers

RIDE DESCRIPTION:

The ride and registration will start at Washoe Park in Anaconda at 7:00 am. There are 4 rides offered, all following Montana's Scenic Byways:

- Turbo 20 – Shuttle to the top of Georgetown Lake Dam – enjoy a 20-mile decent back to Washoe Park.
- 25-mile – Ride to the top of Springhill and back.
- 50-mile – The scenic ride to Georgetown Lake dam, ride around the lake before enjoying the a 17-mile ride back to Washoe Park
- 100-mile – The 50-mile plus an incredible climb up Mill Creek Pass followed by a picturesque ride to the Big Hole River. At the river you will turn around and gradually climb to the top of Mill Creek Pass for a fast decent back to Anaconda.
- Pre-registration is available on-line from USA Cycling

All riders must wear an ANSI/Snell approved helmet and sign a USA Cycling Wavier

Directions to Washoe Park

From the east on I-90:

- At exit 208, take ramp right for MT-1 toward Anaconda / Opportunity - 7.6 mi
- Keep straight onto US-10 ALT North / MT-1 North / E Commercial Ave - 1.2 mi
- Turn right onto Main St - 0.2 mi
- Turn left onto W Pennsylvania St - 0.5 mi
- Arrive at Washoe Park

From the west on I-90:

- At exit 153, take ramp for MT-1 toward Anaconda
- Keep straight to stay on US-10A / MT-1 / Mt Highway 1 / Mt-1 W - 29.7 mi
- Road name changes to MT-1 / Mt-1 W / US-10-ALT - 19.1 mi
- Turn left onto Main St - 0.2 mi
- Turn left onto W Pennsylvania St - 0.5 mi
- Arrive at Washoe Park
